The **Minorities and Philosophy (MAP) Chapter of St Andrews and Stirling** is a group dedicated to making philosophy more inclusive and providing marginalised students with support, resources and a sense of community.



We aim to provide support to all who feel alienated and isolated in philosophy, and specifically speak out on behalf of **women, trans and non-binary people, ethnic minorities, members of the LGBTQIA+ community, working class students, students from non-academic backgrounds, disabled students and students with mental health problems.**

This is achieved through **MAP events**, the **MAP mentoring programme** and **advocacy in the EDI Committee.**

What we do

We run various events on a regular basis including **reading groups** (some of which you can help us organize!), **identity-specific meetups**, **discussion groups** (for instance: on staying in or leaving academia, EDI issues), **application advice sessions**, **parties and hangouts**. The **MAP mentoring programme** provides one-to-one support to undergraduate and conversion diploma students from St Andrews and Stirling. Mentees are matched to a **PhD student mentor**, typically from a similar background, who will provide them with support and guidance throughout the academic year.

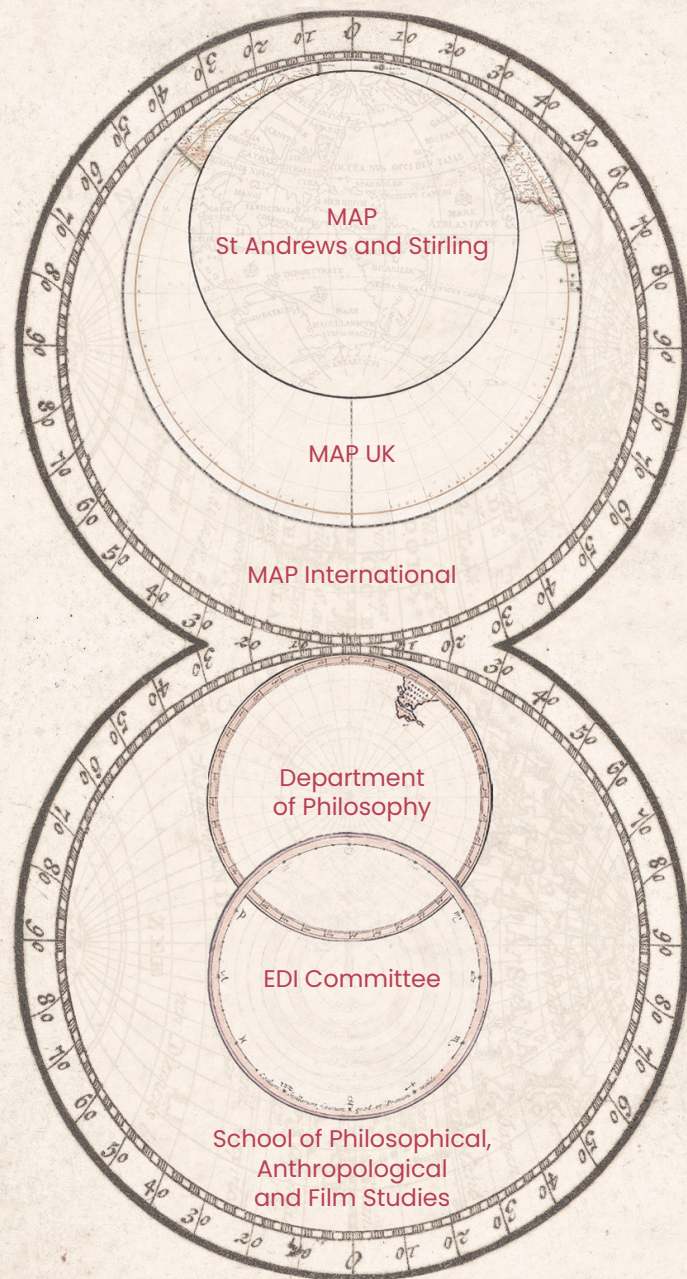

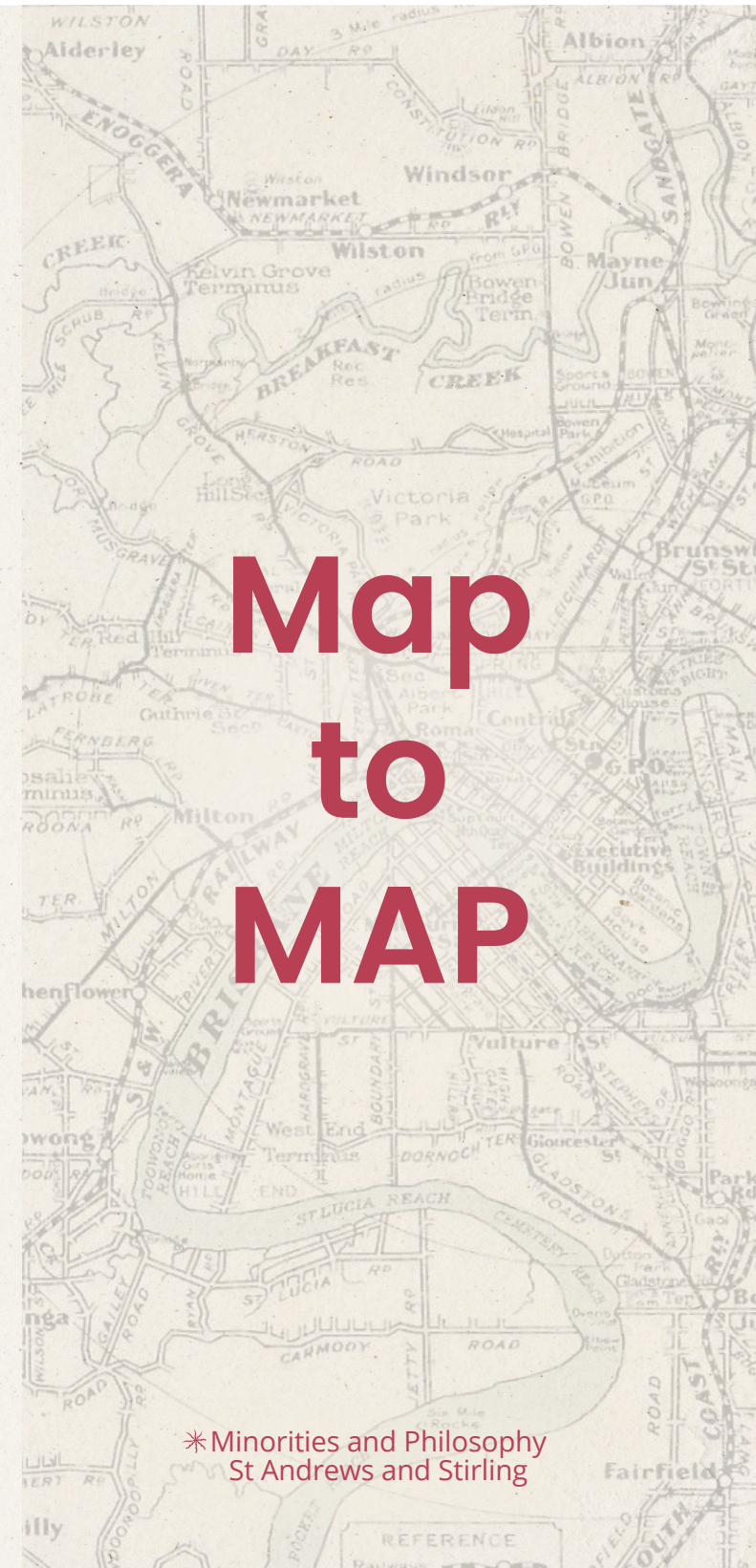
